



National Participant Network (NPN)

POLICY: SOCIAL MEDIA

1. All social media entries, including links, must be connected to disability related issues.
2. All Yahoo list serve entries must be factually-based information. including political topics.
3. Entries based on opinion may be posted on Facebook, but must not contain language or subjects which generally violate community standards or are inflammatory in nature.
4. The NPN Yahoo site is not to be used as an advertising medium for personal gain.
5. Members are encouraged to use Facebook to discuss disability-related topics and to share relevant resources.
6. Any postings that violate the above policies will be removed.
7. Users who knowingly post material that exposes the rest of the community to viruses or other malicious content are subject to immediate removal from the NPN and legal penalties as applicable.
8. All state delegates of the NPN are approved by the Membership committee and can be removed from membership by majority vote by the Membership committee for repeated violations of the Social Media Policy.
9. The NPN Coordinator approves membership of General Members and can remove general members from membership if they repeatedly violate Social Media Policy.
10. To remove a Core Leader for violations of Social Media Policy there is an impeachment process.
