GUIDING PRINCIPLES REGARDING POSITION TITLES FOR PARTICIPANT-DIRECTED PROGRAM EMPLOYEES

- ◆ The NPN supports titles for program employees that reflect the partnership between the employees and participants.
- ◆ The NPN believes that program employees should have position titles that show they are not associated with traditional medical models of service.
- ◆ The NPN believes that program employees should have position titles that indicate the services they supply and show that they support participants of the program.
- ◆ The NPN believes that program employees should have position titles that reflect that the participant is empowered in their relationship, and encourages participants to recognize their own role.
- ◆ The NPN supports simple, sensible, easy-to-remember position titles that all people will understand.
